ADDENDUM-2

In the regulations governing academic programmes under Choice Based Credit System(CBCS) 2013 framed vide this University circular no.CU/CBCS/132/2013 dated 19.07.2013, the following rule is hereby added as rule no.4.7. This Addendum is effective from June 2017.

Rule no.4.7

Special Grace Marks for getting Higher Class.

A candidate who passes in all the subjects and whose total number of marks falls short for securing Second Class or First Class by marks not more than 1% of the aggregate total marks in final semester examinations shall be given the required marks to get the next higher class or grade as the case may be.

The benefits of above mentioned special grace marks shall not be given, if the candidate fails to secure necessary passing marks in the aggregate head of passing.


The students scoring CGPA between 6.45 to 6.49 OR CGPA between 5.45 to 5.49 are only eligible to apply for this kind of special grace.


The concerned students have to apply to the Registrar of C.U.Shah University within one months after declaration of the results on University web/portal and paying the fee decided from time to time by the University.
