### Celebration of International Women's Day March 8, 2016 Details of the event

On Tuesday March 8, 2016, the constituent colleges of C. U. Shah University are going to celebrate the International Women's Day. The celebration is under the guidelines of the University Grants Commission with reference to letter No. F. 91-1/2013 (GS) dated 6<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2015 in accordance with the title "SAKSHAM", D. O. No. 91-3/2013 (TFGS) reported to encourage the programs on the campus related to women empowerment. The goal of Women's Day celebration is to raise visibility and ability of women in various fields of social, economic, education, politics, sports, cultural etc.

- The inaugural function will start at 9:30 am. The function will be graced by the speech of the chief guest and the guest of honors. A prayer dance will be presented by a classical dance.
- After the inaugural function three different events will start to motivate the girl participants.
- First competition: Fancy dress competition with speech (Few characters are listed in Table 1).

## Venue: Auditorium (Mechanical Building)

**Rules:** 

- $\checkmark$  The participant is allowed for max. 5 minutes for her performance.
- ✓ The costume for relevant performance is the responsibility of participant only.
- ✓ For any background facility the participant need to inform to the event coordinator in advance.
- ✓ List is given in Table 1 and participant may take other relevant characters.
- ✓ Language is no binding. Participants may select any of Gujarati, Hindi or English language.

• Second competition: Debate (Topics on the spot)

Venue: Drawing Hall (Ground floor, Diploma Building) Rules:

- ✓ The participants have to follow the guidelines provided by the event coordinators..
- ✓ Team of 3 participants is compulsory for the participation.
- ✓ No language barrier for the participants. They may select any of Gujarati, Hindi or English language.
