28<sup>th</sup> of February, 1928 was the great day in India when an invention in the field of Indian science was completed by the famous Indian physicist, Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman. The day is observed annually to mark the discovery of the Raman Effect (phenomenon of scattering photons). Sir Raman was awarded with the Nobel Prize in physics in 1930 for his discovery and this was the first Nobel Prize for India in the field of science.

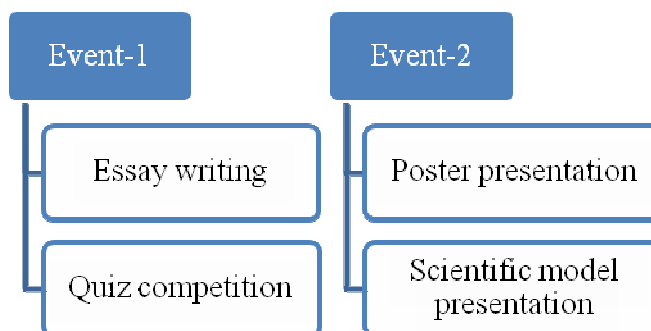
To commemorate and honour this event always in the future, 28<sup>th</sup> of February was asked to the Indian Government to designate as a National Science Day in India by the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC) in the year 1986. From then, the national science day was started celebrating all across the India as a great event in the field of Indian science.
